#### Summary

Responsible for monitoring and controlling rider flow at the top of the water slide at Spring Lake Pool. This position ensures guest safety by enforcing slide rules, spacing riders appropriately, and communicating clearly with lifeguards and other aquatic staff.

#### Qualifications

- Must be at least 16 years of age
- Strong communication and customer service skills
- Ability to follow directions and enforce rules consistently
- Ability to remain attentive for extended periods
- Ability to work outdoors in heat and sun exposure
- Ability to climb stairs repeatedly
- Lifeguard certification is not required.

#### Essential Functions

- Monitor the top platform of the water slide
- Enforce all posted slide rules and rider requirements
- Release riders in a safe and controlled manner, ensuring proper spacing
- Observe rider posture and readiness before dispatch
- Communicate with lifeguards at the bottom of the slide as needed
- Prevent unsafe behaviors such as running, roughhousing, or improper riding position
- Report safety concerns or incidents immediately to supervisor

#### Marginal Functions

- Performs other duties as assigned by supervisor.
- The District encourages its employees to “take ownership” of the District. As such, it is the responsibility of all Park District employees to pick up litter throughout the building, grounds and facilities of the District.
- Staff is expected to help with the successful implementation of programs, parks and services across program areas and between departments.

#### Safety

- All employees are responsible for implementing the policies & procedures that pertain to safety and health.

#### Psychological Considerations

- Must have the ability to deal with other people under stressful conditions and have excellent customer service presence.

#### Physiological Considerations

- Ability to stand for extended periods
- Ability to work outdoors in high temperatures and direct sunlight

#### Cognitive Considerations

- Must exhibit good problem-solving abilities and good judgment in keeping the park district mission.
- Must take initiative and be able to follow directions from and work with supervisors, and co-workers.

#### Hours & Wage Range

This position shall be paid every two weeks at minimum wage and is classified as seasonal, non-exempt employee status. Hours vary based on operational demand, including evenings, weekends, and holidays.
